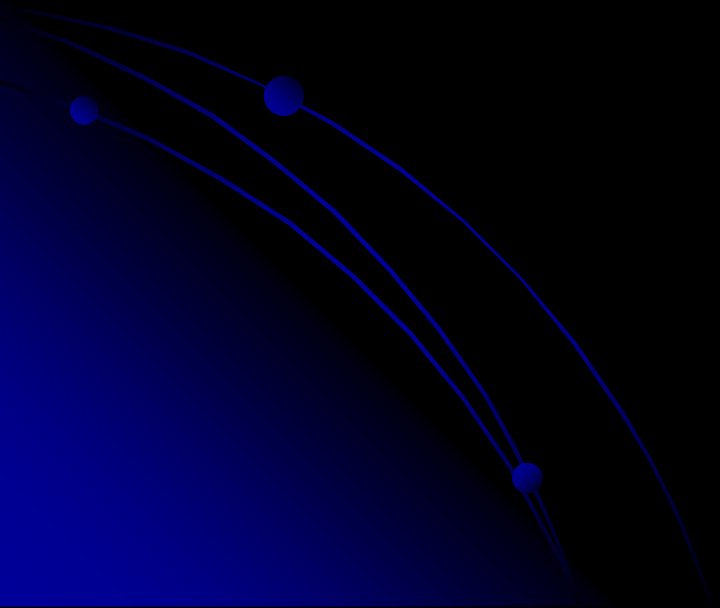





# General Education Assessment AA and AS

# Community College Survey of Student Engagement (CCSSE)

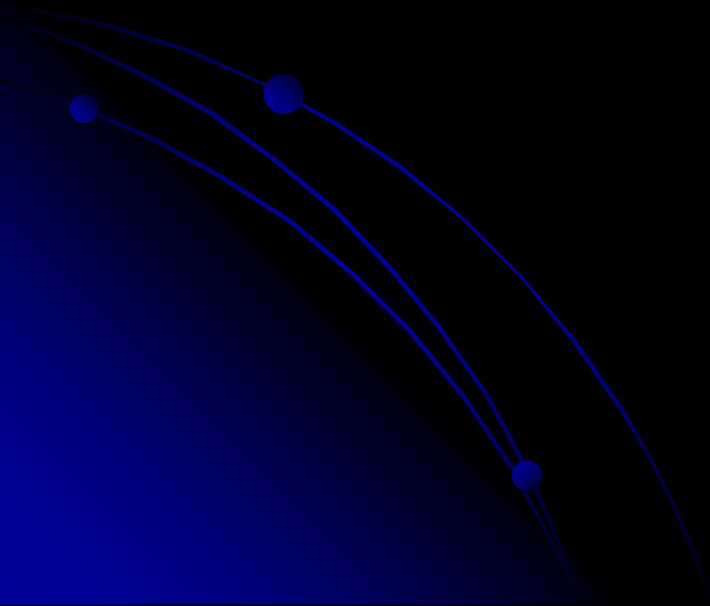
## ● Above the Mean

  - number of part time students who are somewhat likely to withdraw from school because of being academically unprepared
  - number of all students who are likely to withdraw because of lack of finances.


# Community College Survey of Student Engagement (CCSSE)

- Below the Mean

- assignments requiring students to prepare two or more drafts of a paper or assignment before turning it in.
- assignments requiring students to analyze basic elements of an idea, experience, or theory.



# University of Wyoming Transfer Students

- Over a five year period, the number of students transferring from EWC to UW has decreased.
  - The first semester grade point average of EWC transfer students is slightly above the GPA for all Wyoming community college transfer students.
  - The overall GPA for EWC students is higher than all transfer students and UW students.
  - The more credits transferred, the better the first semester UW GPA.

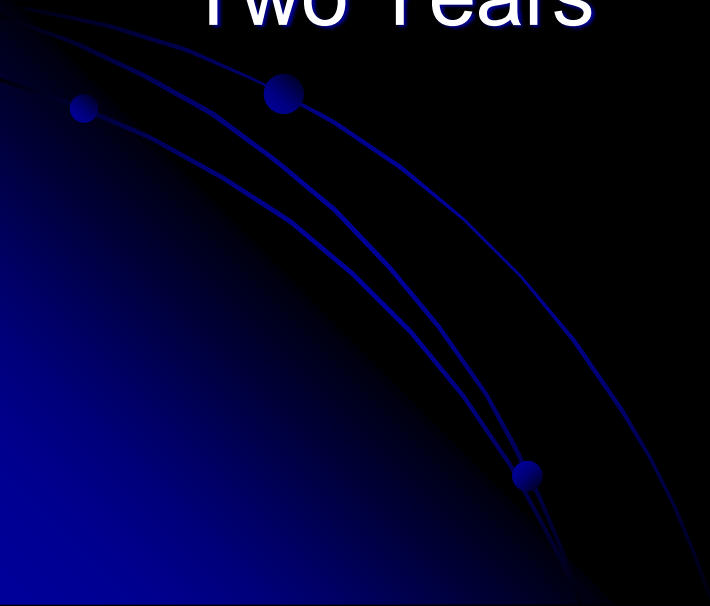
