ACADEMIC AMNESTY

Academic amnesty is Eastern Wyoming College's policy of forgiveness for a student's prior unsuccessful academic record at EWC.

Academic amnesty permits former students to eliminate up to two consecutive semesters credits and grades from their record. The courses and grades will appear on the transcript with a notation that they were granted academic amnesty and are no longer part of the cumulative grade point average, nor may they satisfy EWC graduation requirements. All credits and grades taken during the semester/s will be subject to amnesty.

Former EWC students may petition for academic amnesty only for coursework taken five years previously. The petition shall be submitted to the EWC records office and shall specify the period for which amnesty is requested. Students must petition within a year of resumption of studies. Academic amnesty may be applied only once and is irrevocable.

Since academic amnesty may affect financial aid awards, students receiving financial aid should contact the office of financial aid prior to applying for amnesty.
